There has been no resolution or restitution of funding for the Warwick Mentor **Program.** With the ongoing budget issues in the City of Warwick, the Warwick School Committee voted last Thursday to request additional funding from the City.

## Our stance is "No money, no mentoring."

We need YOUR help to have our beloved Warwick Mentor Program restored to wholeness.

For us, it's a showing of strength in numbers, so your presence is of the utmost importance if you can possibly be there. Bring your friends and family! **There will be opportunities to speak at both meetings, but no obligation to do so.** 

In the interim, together with our board of directors, we are doing everything we can to preserve jobs in anticipation of the Mentor Program being restored. The \$102,000 hit represents 100% of our Warwick Mentor Program and 15% of our organization's annual budget decimating our cash flow.

We have gone through our agency's entire budget line by line and taken a hard look at everything we can cut. I am actively reaching out to our other funders to have payments expedited when possible to get us through this difficult time. **Staff members will forego raises and increase the amount paid toward health insurance. We have suspended our janitorial service, mileage reimbursements and professional development, to name a few.** 

I know from my conversations with Mayor Solomon, school committee and city council members that our supporters **(YOU!)** have been emailing and calling.
