



MENTOR Rhode Island Scholarship Announcement: Up to \$1,500 is Available Through Two Scholarship Opportunities

Application Deadline: Friday, June 17, 2022

MENTOR Rhode Island is pleased to offer two scholarship opportunities to mentees in support of their future goals.

- The Carol Bouchard Memorial Scholarship will award up to \$1,500 to a mentee in the Warwick Mentor Program who has participated in the program for at least two years and is still in contact with their mentor. The award is named in the memory of mentor Carol Bouchard who died in the terrorist attacks of September 11th, 2001.
- 2) The Feinstein Mentee Scholarship will award up to \$1,500 to a mentee from any mentoring program in the state that is known to MENTOR Rhode Island as being a partner in the mentoring movement. The mentee must have participated in the program for at least two years and still be in contact with their mentor. The award is named in honor of the investment philanthropist Alan Shawn Feinstein made to the mentoring movement several years ago.

MENTOR Rhode Island wants its scholarships to be accessible and adaptable to the varied needs, life experiences, and goals of mentees across the state. With that in mind these awards will be given directly to the awardee so they can determine how best to use the support to achieve their goals. Tuition or books for school, travel costs to get to school, or buying tools for a trade apprenticeship are just some of the many possibilities.
